114. SUMMER SCHOOL

It is the policy of the Board that the Centre Learning Community Charter School may conduct a summer program of remedial instruction for students of the Centre Learning Community Charter School in grades 5 through 8.

In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board and Faculty Leadership Team will:

1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.
2. Purchase such books, materials, supplies, and equipment as may be necessary.
3. Utilize school or other facilities as required.
4. Provide necessary custodial services.

Tuition fees shall be charged to all students who participate and shall be set by the Board.

The Staff shall be responsible for developing regulations for:

1. Planning the summer school curriculum.
2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.
3. Pupil and staff assignments.
4. Utilization of facilities.

Such regulations for the operation of the summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of the Centre Learning Community Charter School.
