205. REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS

The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the whole child. It recognizes its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and progress in school. It also recognizes the effects of State Board regulations and Federal Regulations governing school records.

The Board requires that all parents be informed at regular intervals on the progress of their children. The Teaching Staff shall establish means through which this shall be accomplished.

The Board will encourage the administration and staff of Centre Learning Community Charter School schools to devise and maintain a variety of reporting methods so that each parent may be apprised of his/her child's progress in the light of adopted Centre Learning Community Charter School-wide goals.
