216. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board believes that the school should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.

The Board charges each student at Centre Learning Community Charter School with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.

Students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for student actions.

The Board may report to the appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature.

The CEO shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include rules for the safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies and equipment and preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment.

Students and other persons shall be held financially responsible for any school property damaged or lost. The dollar value will be determined by Centre Learning Community Charter School and will be paid by the person, by the student, or his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) on demand of the Centre Learning Community Charter School.

Any person found committing the following may be subject to appropriate fines and/or prison terms:

1. Vandalizing school buildings, structures, grounds, or other property of the Centre Learning Community Charter School;
2. Breaking into a school building;

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3. Gaining entry to a school building or property by trick or deception or secretly remaining in the building;
4. Knowingly remaining on school property that is posted or who is given notice of trespass and refuses to leave;
5. Trespassing on school property.
